## **Ecuador Habla Inglés Evaluation**

Since its inception in early 2020, over 2,000 English teachers across Ecuador have participated in the Ecuador Habla Inglés (EHI) program.

A 2023 independent evaluation demonstrates that teachers experience growth in confidence in English proficiency and improved teaching skills as a result of their participation in the program.

## INCREASED CONFIDENCE IN TEACHERS AND STUDENTS



72% of participating teachers reported that over the last year their confidence in their English language skills had "improved a lot"



71% of participating teachers said that over the last year their confidence in their abilities as a teacher "increased a lot"



**80%** of students of participating teachers say their confidence in their English language skills have improved at least a little


