ISIL's Finances


- ISIL has amassed wealth at an unprecedented pace

- Antiquities are just another resource for ISIL

ISIL's Trafficking in Antiquities

Documents captured during the Abu Sayyaf raid offer proof that ISIL:

- Systematically traffics in antiquities
- Is well organized to traffic in antiquities
- Licenses looting of archaeological sites
- Profits from trafficking in antiquities



Thanks be to the Almighty Allah, prayer and peace upon the Messenger of Allah and upon his Household and Companions and those who followed him, afterwards:

Administrative Order Number / 5 /

It is prohibited for any brother from the Islamic State to excavate antiquities or give the permit to anyone from the public without receiving a stamped permit issued from the Diwan of Natural Resources and Minerals-Antiquities Division.

Any previous assignment or permit to any one is considered null whoever the issuing source might be, holder of such a permit must report to the Diwan of Natural Resources – Antiquities Division to obtain a substitute.

Anyone proven to be in violation of this order, since its issuing date, is considered disobedient to this order and is a subject to penalty in accordance to Sharia courts.
