

Critical Language Enhancement Award (CLEA) Overview - Indonesia

The purpose of the Critical Language Enhancement Award is to cultivate higher levels of language proficiency in Bahasa Indonesia prior to and during the Fulbright grant period. CLEA recipients may opt for formal classroom instruction, private tutoring, or a combination of the two.

Start of Grant:

CLEA grant awardees must begin their language study immediately upon their arrival in Indonesia.

Duration:

The duration of the CLEA grant is for 3 months only. At least 50% of the CLEA grant must be utilized prior to the start of the Fulbright grant. The remaining CLEA grant may run concurrently with the Fulbright student research grant, but must finish at least 30 days prior to the end of the grant period.

Limits on Hours of Study:

CLEA awardees must pursue at least 15-20 hours (@ 3-4 hrs. daily) of language training per week.

AMINEF has identified some institutions and tutors in different cities around Indonesia where CLEA grantees may choose to study. However, grantees have the option to identify institutions or tutors on their own. *Grantees must seek approval for an institution or tutor from AMINEF before enrolling in a language program.*

Grantees must submit original receipts from all language training providers.

Grantees must submit a monthly report and a final report to AMINEF and to ECA.

Funding:

The Critical Language Enhancement Award includes funding for a monthly maintenance stipend, tuition and fees for approved language programs or tutors, a book allowance and health insurance policy as outlined in the CLEA grant document.
